

## Sparks Parent Guide



Sparks Club is for children in Kindergarten-Second Grade. Each handbook builds a foundation of biblical wisdom through memory verse drills, crafts, activities and review of key doctrine and Bible facts. These handbooks will take Sparkies on a chronological journey through Scripture — Genesis through Revelation — with regular layovers to meet important Bible characters along the way. Each book includes verse memory sections, Bible biographies, and activities.

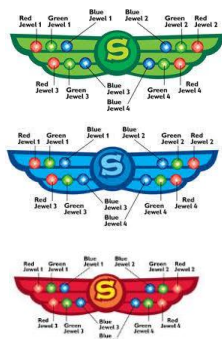
The Sparks Handbooks:

- **1<sup>st</sup> year in Sparks:** Hang Glider: Genesis-Joshua
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Year in Sparks:** Wing Runner: Judges-birth of Christ
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Year in Sparks:** Sky Stormer: birth of Christ-Revelation



All new children in the Sparks program will begin by completing the Flight 3:16 booklet. Once they complete the Flight 3:16 booklet, they will receive their uniform vest and handbook.

Clubbers progress at their own pace in Sparks, but in order to complete one book in a year their goal should be to complete two sections most weeks. Sections in each Sparks handbooks are grouped into a Rank Path, four Red Jewels and four Green Jewels. All sections in the book must be completed in order, section by section, with the exception of the Bring-A-Friend section. Clubbers can continue working through their books even if this section is not completed. Sparks earn awards for both section/unit completions as well as the end of handbook year end awards. If a clubber is unable to Bring-a-Friend they can complete a service project instead. There are awards for club and church attendance as well. If your clubber finishes their handbook early there are extra credit books available.

### Wings section/unit Completion (club nights)

Each club night begins at 6:30pm and ends at 8:00pm. AWANA Sparks rotate through a variety of activities which include Games/Crafts, Large Group Lesson Time, and Small Group/Handbook time. Please have your clubber bring their uniform, Bible, handbook and running shoes for games time each week.

We strongly encourage you to work with your child in their AWANA handbook! Help them memorize the Bible verses and talk with them about what that verse means and how they can use it in their life. Read the Bible passages and answer the questions as a family. The handbooks have tools (online resources have the biographies, verses and songs!) and practical suggestions to help you as you learn and study together. Just a few minutes a day can yield eternal rewards!
