Position Summary:

To invest in the lives of couples by coming alongside them for the purpose of:

Ministry Vision:

Time Commitment:

- Time commitment is approximately 6-8 hours per couple. Approximately 3-4 couples per year.

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Married for at least ten years and meet the CSC criteria for marriage. (See Definition of Marriage in Wedding Handbook)
- Be in a life giving relationship with your spouse where respect and honour are lived out in practical ways that model Christ's love

- Seek to live and grow in accordance with the standards of Scripture. I Timothy 3
- Faithful and consistent in church attendance as part of the CSC community
- Communicate the basics of faith to help couples build spiritually healthy marriages.
- Take the following Discovery courses
 - Volunteer Leadership Training (recommended)
 - Discover Your Design (recommended)
 - Discover Your Church (for church membership)
 - Submit a Getting Involved form and sign the Lifestyle Agreement (if not already completed for another ministry)
 - Be an active member of CSC (or working toward CSC membership)
