Position Summary:

GMT Trip Leaders serve by leading CSC teams which are engaging, encouraging and enhancing the ministries of our Global Workers, Church Partners and Associate Agencies. They may serve locally, nationally or internationally. Leaders will shepherd and guide global teams under the direction of Global Teams Lead and our in-country host partners.

Ministry Vision:

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Previous cross-cultural experience in a team environment
- Previous positive leadership and volunteer engagement experience
- Strong cross-cultural communication skills

- Regular in-person attendance at a CSC Campus
