MAIN POINT:

God's Power Guides Me

MEMORY VERSE:

"The Lord gives me strength and protects me. He has saved me. He is my God, I will praise him. He is my father's God, and I will honor him." Exodus 15:2

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

God called Moses up Mount Sinai. While he was there, God gave Moses the ten commandments on stone tablets. They included:


- 1-there is only one God
- 2-we should not have any false gods before Him
- 3-do not misuse God's name
- 4-remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy
- 5-honour our father and mother
- 6-do not kill
- 7—keep your marriage vows
- 8-do not steel
- 9-do not give a false witness against your neighbor
- 10-do not covet

God gave the commandments to give to Moses, who passed them on to the Israelites. The Bible teaches us to love God and to love others. He gave us the ten commandments as a guide to help us.

DO IT → TEN COMMANDMENTS SOAP CARVING

Supplies:

- Bar of soap (2 per child)
- Wood carving stick (1 per child)
- Paper or plastic plate (to catch soap shavings)
- Roman numerals reference (see last page)

Activity Instructions:

Give your child 2 bars of soap.

Have your child carve the Roman numerals 1-5 on one bar of soap; and the Roman numerals 6-10 on the second bar of soap. Remind them to carve over the plate to catch the shavings.

Your child can carve the soap to have rounded edges or any other shape they desire.



The Point

God gave Moses the 10 commandments. Your soap carvings can remind you of God's commandments and His desire for you to love God and love others.

TALK ABOUT IT:

Do this section with your child while they are assembling their craft.

- 1. What is a rule at home or school that you find difficult to follow? (Remembering to put my shoes away, doing a chore without being reminded, going to bed on time, brushing my teeth, being kind to a sibling when they do something I don't like.)
- 2. Jesus summed up the ten commandments by saying we should love God and love others. What is one way that you can love God? (Spend time with Him reading the Bible and praying, put Him before other things we love to do, follow God's ways as described in the Bible, treat other people with love, serve God by volunteering.)

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3. What is one way that you can share God's love with someone who may need to hear it? (Tell someone about Jesus/salvation, serve others by helping them, pray for someone, listen to someone who needs to talk, say kind and encouraging words to someone, give someone a letter or a drawing, tell someone you are thankful for them.)

FAMILY PRAYER:

Dear God, thank you for giving us the 10 Commandments to help us love and follow you. Help us show your love to our friends and family. Thank you for being a loving and forgiving God. Amen.
